31st July 2022 – Eighteenth Sunday of Year C

This weekend approximately 200 people from our Diocese, including some from our parish, are taking part in the annual pilgrimage to Lourdes. Fr David Long, the pilgrimage director, writes: 'This Friday, our Diocese returns to Lourdes after a two-year absence. It is a joy to be able to return to this wonderful place of pilgrimage. We will keep the whole Diocese very much in our thoughts and prayers throughout the pilgrimage. If you wish to join us via the livestream for the International Mass on Sunday 31st July at 9.00am BST, and our Mass at the grotto on Monday 1st August at 9.00am BST, please go to the Sanctuaries website www.lourdes-france.org and click on the link.' Throughout the pilgrimage, Bishop Mark will be praying for the renewal of the Diocesan Pilgrimage, for peace in the world especially in Ukraine and Russia, for the people of our diocese that they may return to the Eucharist, and for all our young people amidst the uncertainties of the present time. Let us unite our prayers with the pilgrims in Lourdes.

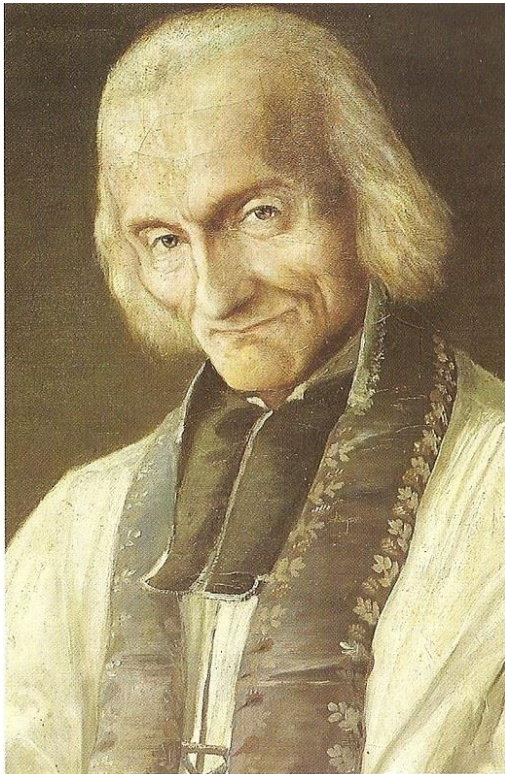
